

**STATEMENT OF OBJECTIVES
FOR
F-117A ACQUISITION AND SUSTAINMENT INTEGRATION
SUPPORT CONTRACT**

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

Lockheed Martin Skunk Works (LMSW) in conjunction with the F-117A System Program Office (SPO) will develop a Total System Performance Responsibility (TSPR) concept for depot-level acquisition and sustainment weapon system support. The concept will be designed to accomplish tasks currently performed on the FY98 contract and tasks presently performed by the F-117A SPO (including the Development System Program Office (DSPO) tasks.) The TSPR concept will:

- provide acquisition and sustainment support to Air Combat Command (ACC) equal to or better than the level currently provided by the SPO, at a reduced cost to the Air Force.
- develop system support metrics that measure the contractor's ability to meet these program objectives.
- result in a significant reduction in SPO size.

CONTRACT OBJECTIVES

The contractor shall develop an acquisition and sustainment system support approach that will:

- be described in a Statement of Work (SOW) developed by LMSW and SPO personnel, with delivery not later than 27 Feb 1998.
- begin operation on 1 Oct 1998, for a contract period of five years, with one 3-year option.
- describe the implementation plan for transition from SPO support systems to LMSW support systems no later than 27 Feb 98.
- incorporate innovative, measurable processes needed to implement and maintain the new support concept.

MANAGEMENT OBJECTIVES

The management objectives are to:

- provide maximum flexibility for the contractor to meet SOO program objectives.
- utilize an integrated product team approach to develop the Statement of Work.
- develop progress reports required for presentation through the Air Force chain of command.
